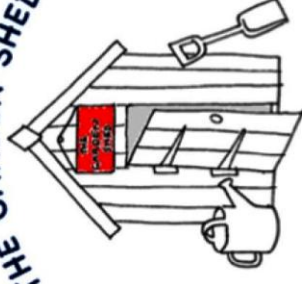

We were overwhelmed by the generosity of neighbours who opened their gardens and all those who attended, resulting in a donation of just under £1,500 to this worthy cause.

Other events included a behind the scenes visit to Hardy's Nursery, guided walking safari tour of Knepp estate to experience their re-wilding project and a trip to Leonardlee lakes and garden to see the autumn colours. We were also fortunate to have the continued support of Tina who provided us with a complimentary area in the Stepping Stones Pub, where we welcomed Everett Leeds to share his passion for clematis and Graham Pattison who offered valuable tips on growing shrubs and climbers. As in previous years our Christmas Craft Workshop was as popular as ever, and in response to feedback we offered more biodegradable and recycled materials to work with. The results were even more impressive than in previous years and everyone left with festive colourful decorations and memorable gifts.
